Do you have a mental health related project that needs funding help?

The Rotary Club of Saginaw – Downtown annually hosts a Saginaw on Stage springtime fundraising concert. And that concert usually results in us awarding a chosen beneficiary between \$5,000 and \$15,000.

Since Saginaw on Stage began in 2003, we have provided funds for construction, equipment, operations and special projects for the Saginaw Bay Symphony Youth Orchestra, Saginaw Choral Society, Child and Family Services, Saginaw City Police Department, Saginaw City Fire Department, Mustard Seed Shelter House, Covenant Kids, Hearts of Michigan Girl Scouts, the building of a pavilion in a Little League park way too many to list.

What we require from potential beneficiaries is a DETAILED written proposal. Please include what the project is, its purpose, the cost, how it will benefit the community and if it would need funding for more than one year. Sometimes our beneficiary has been a repeat.

We do tend to favor nonprofit institutions or service organizations like the fire department and police department.

We also tend to prioritize asset and program development over operating costs. We have no problem that you would need money from additional sources to make your project happen.

We require a full detailed report after the money is awarded with how you spent the money along with results.

For the 2024 Saginaw on Stage event, our Rotary club is looking for an organization that is in the mental health field because Rotary International has made mental health Issues a priority around the world this year and is asking its member clubs to participate with initiatives.

Submitting a proposal does not mean you will be chosen as the beneficiary.
